

# Medical Students Cultural Exchange **MSCE 2019**

**MSCE** (Medical Students Cultural Exchange) is a one-week summer camp held in Sanzhi, Taiwan (north of Taipei) at Mackay Medical College. We bring a team of 14-16 American students (rising undergraduate sophomores and above) preparing to apply for, as well as students already training in the fields of medicine, nursing, and hearing and speech pathology to serve as camp teaching assistants (TAs).

The 60-70 other camp participants are Taiwanese college students who are also studying in the same health-related fields. The camp program involves presentations on culture and healthcare from US and Taiwan students, as well as relation-building activities, all in English. In addition, American TAs introduce their Christian faith to Taiwanese students with morning Bible studies, breakfast testimonies, a praise night event, and numerous less structured opportunities for friendly conversation.

In addition, the successful candidate has strong people skills, initiative, and is a team player. Those in health-related fields such as public health, dentistry, pharmacy, physical therapy and medical research are also welcome to apply.

This year's camp will take place from **JULY 7 to JULY 14** with a service internship set in rural Taiwan for the following week, **JULY 15 to JULY 21**. Some financial aid (usually about \$500- 700 to help defray air ticket expenses, along with most camp-related living expenses covered) is available. Deadline for applications is **MARCH 2019**.
